Scribe and from the Judge's view Clinics

We've arranged for a scribe and from the judge's view clinic to be held at Lynn Hamler's Farm on Sunday, June 3rd at 2:00. We will have volunteers riding at various levels and Lynn has offered her services as judge for both clinics. Please let me know if you will be attending so that I can make enough copies of the tests. You'll have opportunities to scribe as well as discuss tests from Introductory through 4th level as well as the Young Rider test. The sessions will run back to back and should last about 1 1/2 hours for each session. We will do the scribing clinic first followed by the judge's view clinic. Tests to be ridden will be:

Introductory test 2
Training level test 3
First level test 1
Second level test 1
Third level test 2
Fourth level test 2
FEI Young rider test

Directions to Lynn Hamler-Ocker's place for the clinic.

Take 71 north to State Rt 95 east,

from 95 east take State Rt 314 north.

After 3-4 miles on 314 look for the A&C Tarp sign then look for County Rd 14 which is also Yankee St.

Turn right, Lynn is 3 miles on the left, house number is 7559.

Lynn is 5 minutes from 71, if questions call her at (740) 694-5150.

Awards

The club members finalized the awards program for this year.

Awards will be broken into schooling and rated shows. Only those classes shown under a USDF or USAE licensed judge will qualify.

Within each category there will be awards for rider with any horse or horses and horse awards.

Rider awards will be for open, jr/young rider and vintage (over 50). A minimum of 4 scores from 2 different judges will be required with one of the scores from the highest test in the level.

Horse awards will be an average of a minimum of 4 scores from 2 different judges within the level.

Copies of tests for shows other than the Down Centerline series should be sent to Amy Rothe-Heiter.

New USA Equestrian rule:

Horse identification numbers will be required for all horses competing in USAE and USDF competitions. There will be no charge for horse ID numbers that are issued via the internet to members of USA Equestrian or its affiliates for : 1) horses that are also Annual and life recorded, registered or otherwise identified or listed with a USA Equestrian discipline affiliate, or 2) horses registered with a USA Equestrian breed affiliate. Horses not meeting the above criteria must have a complete identification certificate submitted with the application for a horse ID number before a number will be issued. Horse

ID numbers issued via mail will be charged \$10. Horse ID numbers issued at a competition will be charged \$20.

Fees or penalties for hard copy application have been waived until Dec. 1, 2003.

Don't forget that the USDF rule for horse ID numbers is effective October 1, 2002.
