ODS says a big **CONGRATULATIONS** to several ODS members for reaching one of their riding goals.

Lauren Chumley earned the last score she needed to qualify for her USDF Silver medal at the August ODS DownCenterline show. A rider must have four scores above 60% - two of them must be at Fourth Level and two at Prix St. George. Yeah, Lauren!

Amy Rothe-Hietter needed only two more scores for her USDF Bronze medal. To earn the Bronze medal a rider must have six scores above 60% - two at First Level, two at Second Level and two at Third Level. Amy earned one at the August ODS DownCenterline Show and the last one at Paxton Farm the weekend of August 24, 25 and 26. Yippee, Amy!

The third member to be congratulated is Jennifer Roth. Jen earned the last score she needed to qualify for her small "r" judging license. To become a small "r" judge a person must graduate "with distinction" from the USDF "L" judge program and earn 5 scores at 65% or higher at Fourth Level or above. Way to go, Jen!
